Fresh Start Initiative

On April 6, 2022, the U.S. Department of Education (ED) announced an initiative—called "<u>Fresh</u> <u>Start</u>"—to help eligible borrowers in default.

Fresh Start will continue through one year after the COVID-19 payment pause ends.

Benefits

You can regain student aid benefits:

- Access to Federal Student Aid
- Stopped Collections
- Eligibility for Other Government Loans
- Restored Ability to Rehabilitate Loans
- Access to Student Loan Forgiveness Programs
- Access to Short-term Relief (Forbearance and Deferment)
- Access to Income-Driven Repayment (IDR) Plans

Eligible Loans:

- Defaulted William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan (Direct Loan) Program loans
- Defaulted Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL) Program loans
- Defaulted Perkins Loans held by ED

Process:

- Population 1
 - The school will need to upload a copy of the Loan Status History page from NSLDS that shows the effective date of the default as outlined in the <u>Electronic</u> Announcement.
 - The school will need to have a signed Student and/or Parent Default
 Acknowledgment form (Campus Ivy's CORE>Student Profile>Add Documents
 Needed>Parent or Student Default Acknowledgement Form)
- Population 2 & 3
 - The school will need to upload a copy of the Loan Status History page from NSLDS that shows the effective date of the default as outlined in the <u>Electronic</u> <u>Announcement</u>.

- The President of MCU must review the documents and sign off
 - Send the President a password protected link to confidential student documents to review and approve
 - Approval will be via email per MCU's Electronic Signature policy
